Project Description:

The Department has received a request to issue a permit renewal/modification and has drafted an Air State Facility permit under Article 19 (Air Pollution Control) of the Environmental Conservation Law, for the facility identified as Revere Copper Products, located at One Revere Park, Rome, NY 13440.

The department has made a tentative determination, subject to public comment or other information, to approve the renewal/modification application of the Revere Copper Products facility, a copper products manufacturer. The Air State Facility Permit allows the operations of emission units, U-ANNE1, U-CAST1, U-COMB1, UFURN1, U-GALV1, U-OVER1, and the U-ROLL1, which includes copper annealing, furnaces to melt and pour copper and copper alloy, combustion sources for heat, furnaces to heat copper cake before rolling, shaving the outside of copper alloy materials, a zinc-tin coating operation, and the rolling of copper and copper alloy sheets. The facility is no longer subject to EPA regulations 40 CFR 63 subpart TTTTTT for Secondary Nonferrous Metals Processing Area Sources, since it no longer processes brass. The facility is no longer subject to EPA regulations 40 CFR 63 subpart JJJJJJ for Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Boilers Area Sources, since it has been, and will continue to, operate its boilers as natural gas fired boilers, as defined in subpart JJJJJJ. The facility has capped out of Title V Permitting and Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) requirements by tracking and restricting its emissions of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs), particulates, particulate matter less than 10 microns (PM-10), and carbon dioxide equivalents (CO_{2e}) below major source levels. Facility-wide emissions are capped below the major source thresholds of 10 tons per year for Individual HAP emissions, 25 tons per year for total HAP emissions, 100 tons per year for particulates and PM-10, and 100,000 tons per year of CO_{2e}. Emissions are also capped at 25 tons per year for particulates and 15 tons per year for PM-10 on emission at a process level for certain copper melting furnaces to avoid requirements under PSD regulations.

Availability of Application Documents:

Filed application documents, and Department draft permits where applicable, are available for inspection during normal business hours at the address of the contact person. To ensure timely service at the time of inspection, it is recommended that an appointment be made with the contact person.
